

MS. CASTILLO-PARRALES'S CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS & PROCEDURES

Expected Daily Participation

You will be held accountable on a daily basis to uphold the N House Student Expectations. Meeting the 'Basic Expectation' (listed on the backside) will earn you 7 points per week. You can earn a maximum of 12 points per week if you are 'Going Above and Beyond' (see backside) the 'Basic Expectations'. Any points you earn over 10 are considered extra credit participation points. Points can also be taken away for not meeting the basic expectations and/or not following the class procedures. But you can also gain those lost points back during that same week for a maximum of 9 points for the week. Once points are taken away during that week you are no longer eligible to earn 10 or more points. The points will be entered into the grade book on a weekly to biweekly basis (every 1-2 weeks).

Class Procedures

1. Come on time to class- if you're not inside the class by the time the bell rings you are tardy.
2. Come prepared to class with **all materials**- no going to your locker during class time.
3. Respect and value your opportunity to a free education and that of your other classmates.
4. Please respect all property in this class and return all materials from me to its original place.
5. Students will get one bathroom pass per grading period (every 6 weeks).
-Permission to use the bathroom during videos or lectures will be denied.
6. Get water from class fountain before the bell rings or five minutes after the class has begun.
7. If absent it is your responsibility to get and complete all work.
-Look at Table of Contents on back wall for what you missed in notebook. If it's a worksheet or handouts they will be located in the bins below the Table of Contents. For any other work, ask another student and/or me or visit my website at www.castilloworldhistory.com
8. Cell phones should be turned off or put on silent mode during class. Using your cell phone- this includes texting, and/or playing games is NOT permitted!
9. Using an iPod or other electronic device in class is NOT permitted!
10. Participating in and/or demonstrating irresponsible behavior (*i.e. not being on task, working on another teacher's assignment instead of mine, etc.*)
11. No eating or drinking in class. (Only water- no sodas or juice even if it has a cap!)
12. Before using any classroom computer or printer, please get teacher permission.
13. Please don't acknowledge student aides that come in to deliver or pick up items.
14. Make-up should not be applied during class (applying lip balm okay).
15. Please keep all of your body parts to yourself, don't use them to bother or play with others.
16. Please do not line up at the door- the bell will dismiss
17. Follow all school rules in SVHS' Student Handbook (*i.e.* Dress Code)
