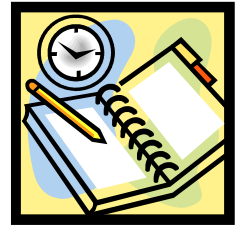


Interactive Notebook Guidelines – World History 10 (Ms. Castillo-Parrales)



Purpose of Notebook (NB): NB's are kept as a way of helping you record, organize, and process new information. NBs will be organized into units and will follow a left side - right side orientation. Generally speaking, student created knowledge goes on the left and factual information on the right.

Grading of Notebooks (Pertain to Classwork/Homework Grade Category)

- NB's will be graded and collected at the end of a unit during class
- NB's will be graded twice: a peer check in class and then by the teacher.
- NB's are worth 270 points and must be turned in on due date. (LATE NB's MUST FOLLOW LATE POLICY)
- Only NB's that have earned a "C" or higher are acceptable- those scoring a "C-" (192 points) or less will have to come in during lunch on assigned days "RE DO" their NB for a higher grade.
 - During a Re DO the highest grade a student can earn is a "B-" or 216 points.
 - Only students who have turned in their NB on the due date or have followed the LATE WORK POLICY are eligible for the REDO.

Stamps: Stamps will be given for completing classwork and homework on time and for participation in class. Stamps are worth 5 points each and are counted when NB's are graded. Although stamps are given in the NB they are not counted as part of the NB grade - they are a completely separate category!
